

# Evangel Christian Academy: 2024-25 Student Supplies -Secondary Campus

## 1) For ALL 6th-12th grade students, beginning the first day of school:

- **Kleenex:** Students are to bring **two boxes** of Kleenex on the first day of school and turn in to 1st period
- **Composition Books:**
  - **High School: SIX (6)** Mead-type, lined comp books for Bible, Science, Humanities, Foreign Lang, Math
  - **Middle School : THREE (3)** Mead-type, lined comp books for Science, and Humanities (2)
- **Quad-ruled graphing:** 1 quad ruled comp book for Math (in addition to the regular lined comp books)
- **Pens:** Three each red, blue, and black
- **Pencils:** 1 package of pencils (mechanical are fine)
- **Ruler:** Twelve-inch
- **Index Cards:** Three packs, white, lined, 3x5" (Middle School will use for Latin, High School for various classes)
- **Paper:** 3 packs of Loose-leaf, wide or college-ruled
- **Post-it notes:** **3 pads in size:** 1x1-2" or smaller, in three different colors, **AND 2 pads** 3x3, 2 different colors
- **Graph paper:** One pack, three-hole punched
- **Glue sticks:** Two
- **Highlighters:** Set of six, chisel-tip
- **Scissors**
- **Colored Pencils-**8 pack or more with different colors
- **Protractor (for Geometry and higher)**
- **White board markers** (4 different colors) and eraser
- **Bible with Concordance:** ESV, NIV, NKJV, or NASB

**Binders:** Two 1.5" binders: one for Grammar/Writing for all 6th/7th & one for 6th-8th Latin classes

i. **TI-84: any version**

1. **Note:** The advanced capabilities are needed, and the TI-84 also meets all of the testing requirements and parameters.
